

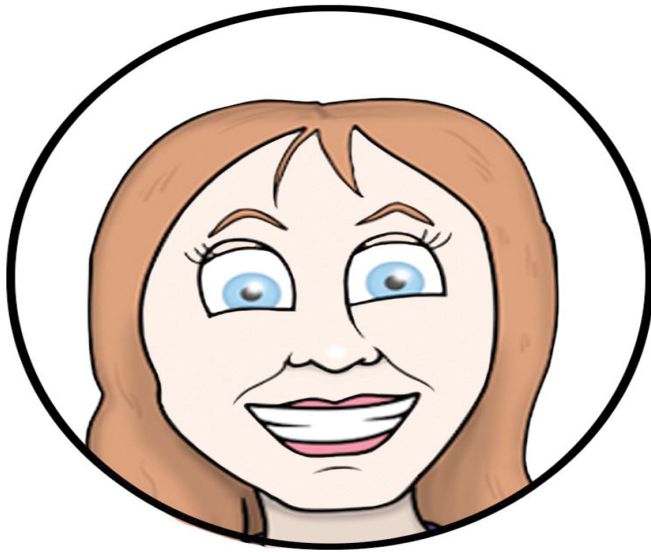

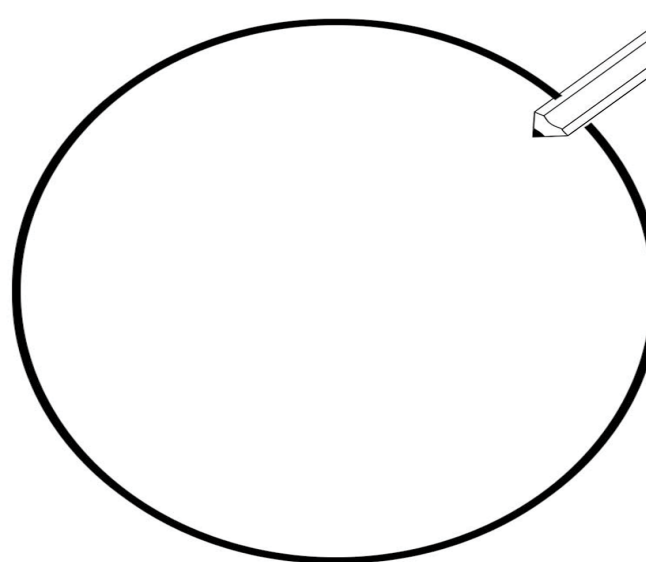

basket.











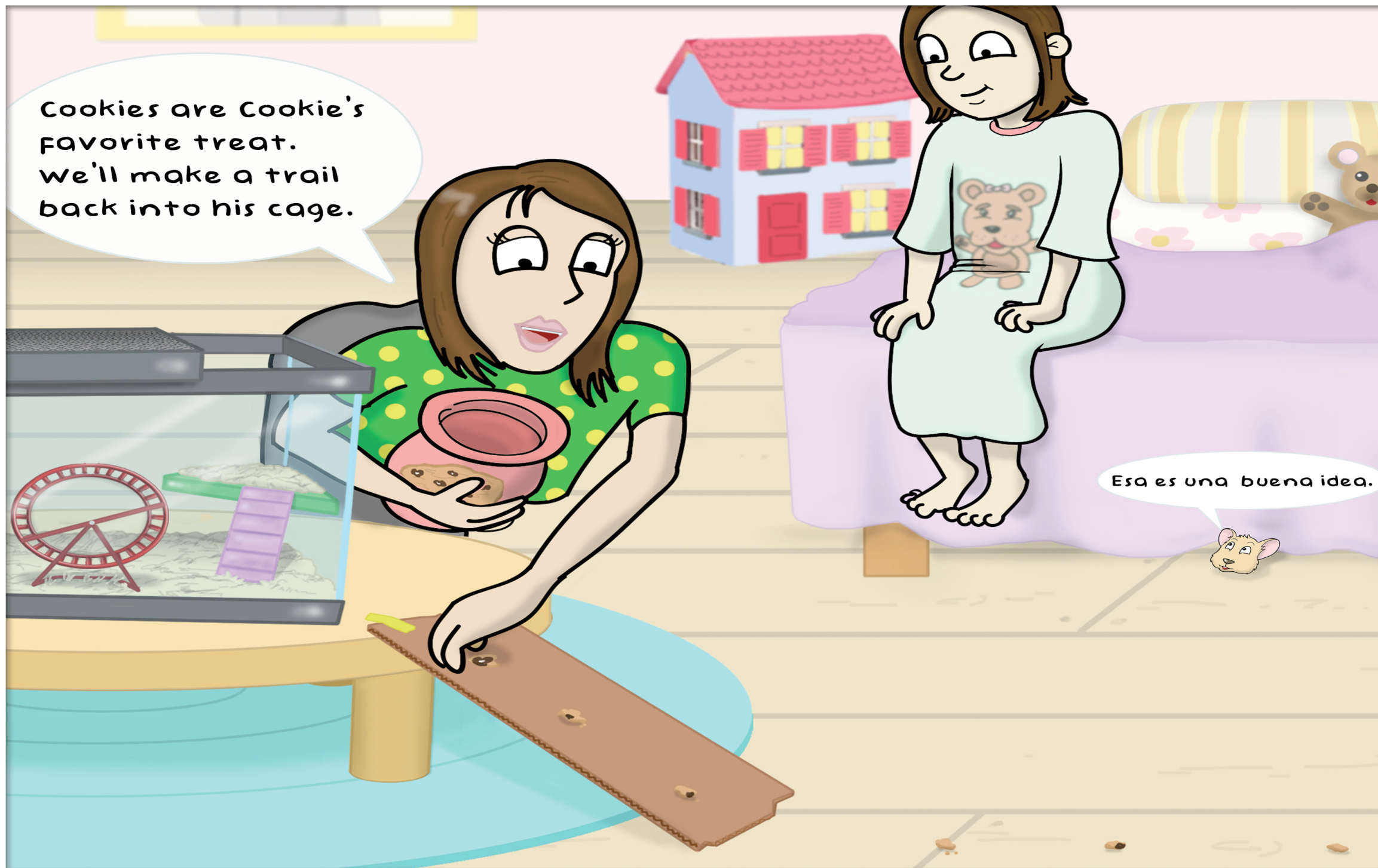

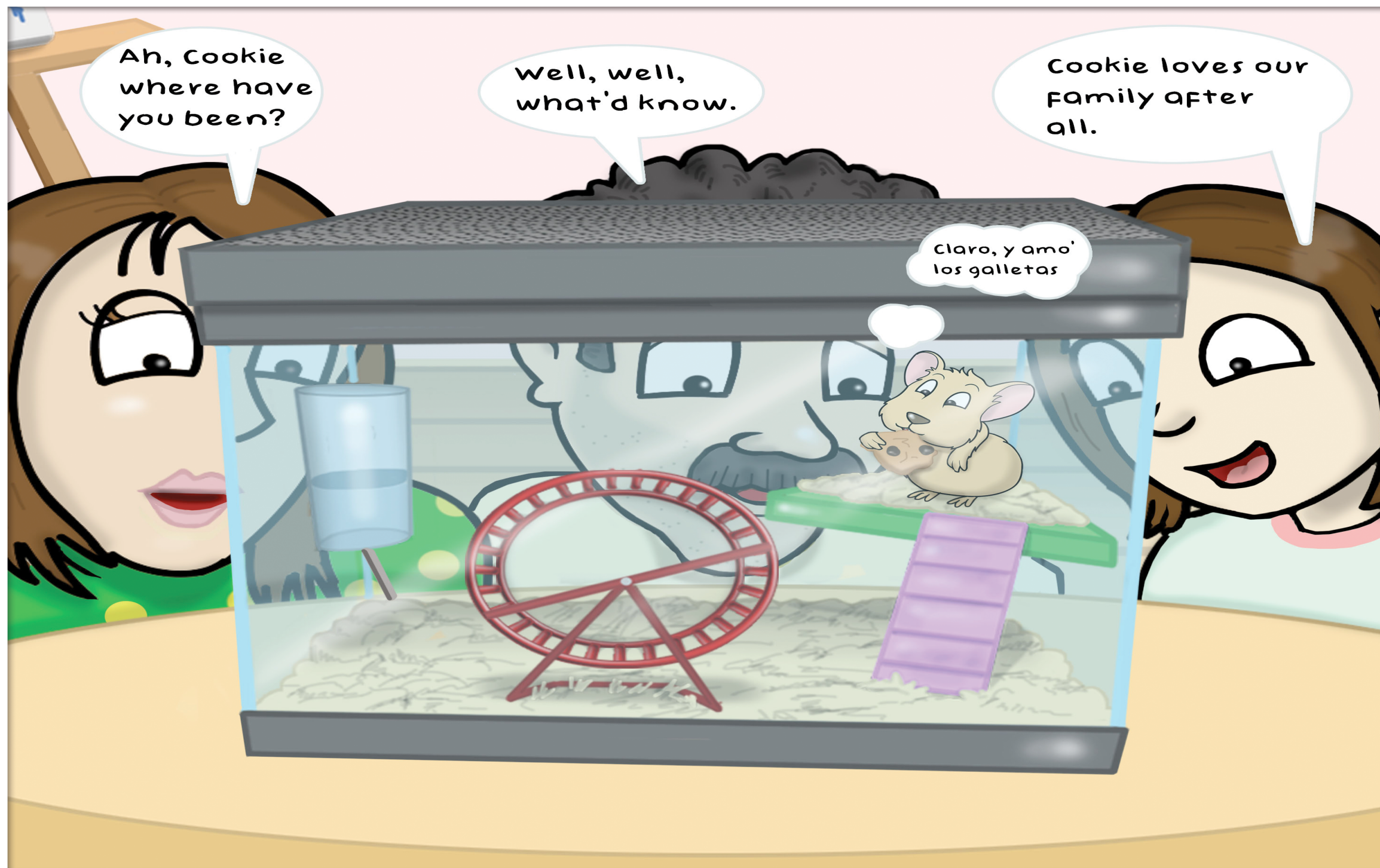

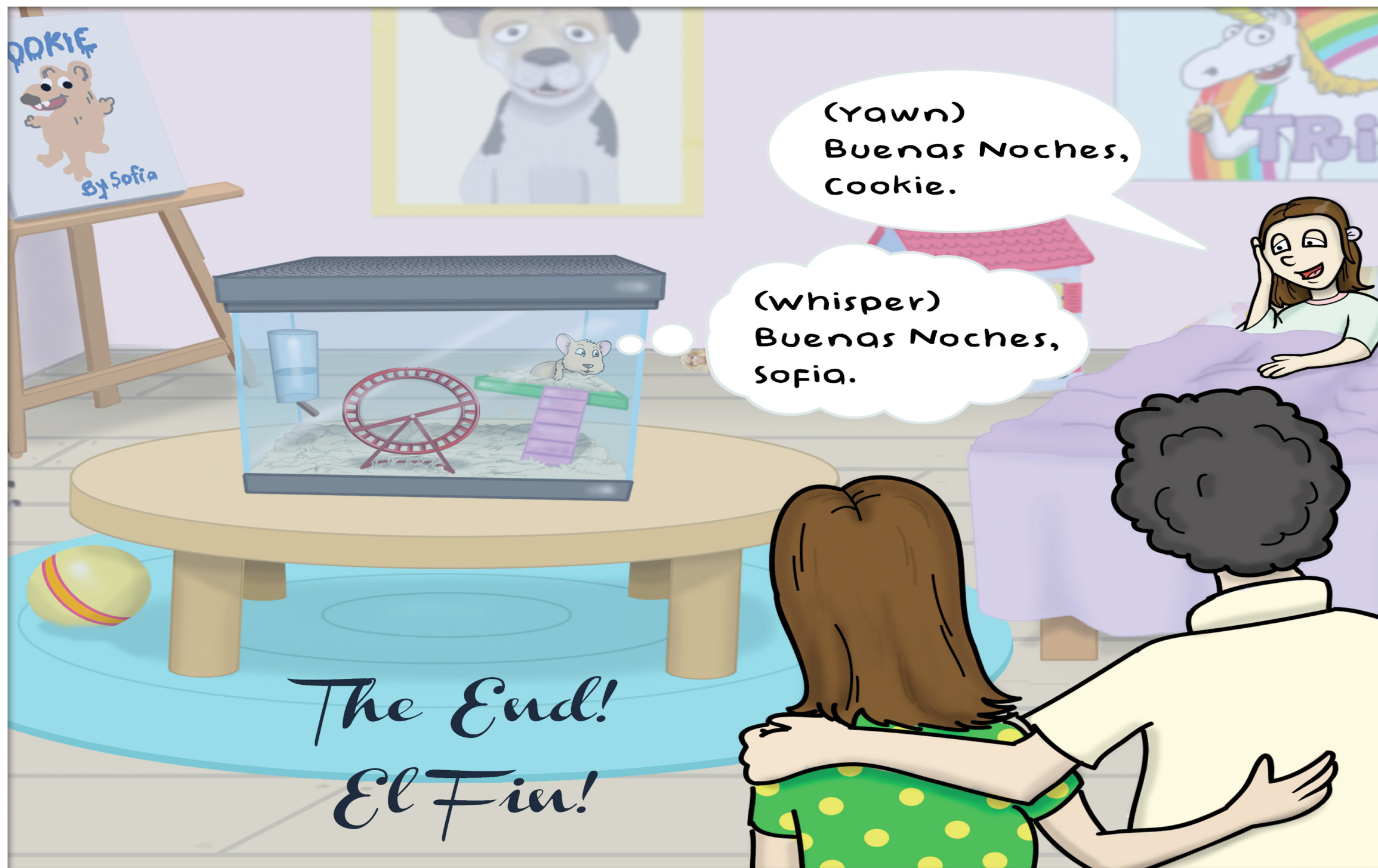

Pg. 12...Claro, y amo' los galletas. Sure, and I love cookies.

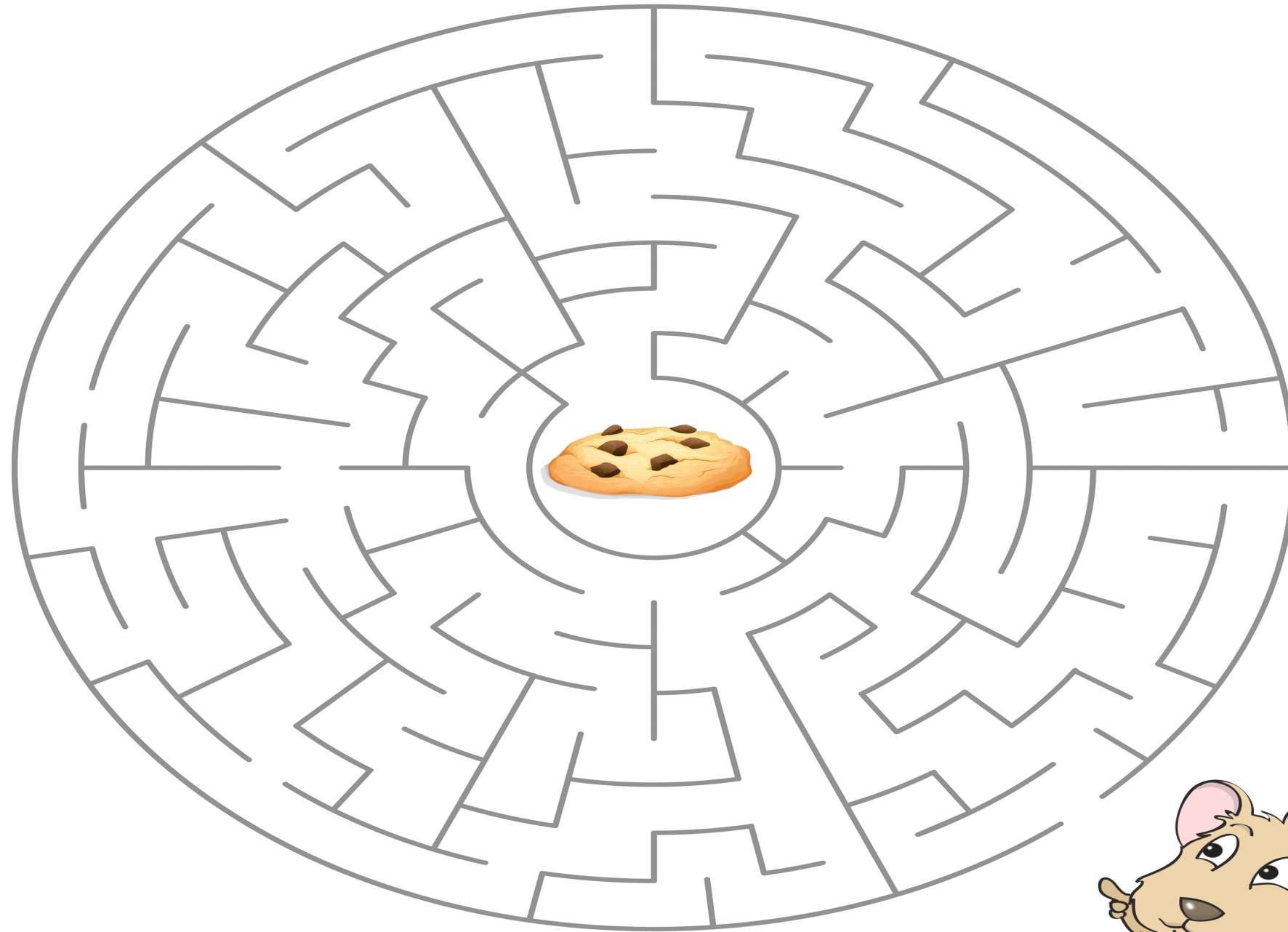

Can you get Cookie the cookie?





**As an in home massage therapist for the past 35 years, I have met many families in the greater Los Angeles area. And, as a person whose hobby is writing, the kernels for many of my books stem from some of these families.**

**During a massage treatment, one of my mommies said how she had been awakened at 6:00 a.m. that morning by her daughter screaming, “Mommy, Mommy, Cookie’s missing” ...Cookie being her child’s pet hamster.**

**This statement immediately appealed to the writer in me...what a darling idea for a children’s book. I shared this thought with my illustrator, Mike, and he did what he always does...he ran with it. Within a week “Mommy” materialized, first as illustrations and then as text (the opposite of our usual approach).**

**Choosing pre-school/ kindergarten age children as our target audience, we have combined simple English vocabulary with simple Spanish vocabulary. This format makes “Mommy, Mommy, Cookie’s Missing” a simple, bilingual experience for the children who read it.**
